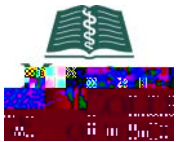
# Faculty Award: Earnestine Willis, MD, MPH

  - secondary appointment in the Institute of Health & Society at the Medical College of Wisconsin



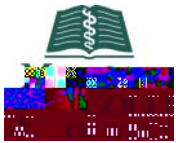
# NOTABLE ACCOMPLISHMENTS

  - Breastfeeding Employers Support Time



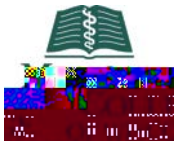

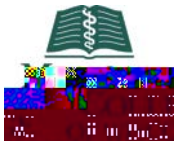
# NOTABLE ACCOMPLISHMENTS

# Staff Award: Melissa DeNomie, MS

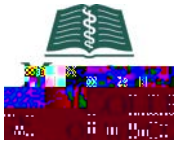
- Research Coordinator, Department of Family & Community Medicine's Center for Healthy Communities & Research

  - supports numerous MCW faculty in community engaged research projects that address a wide range of health-related topics





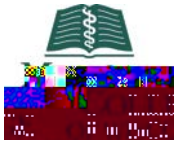
# Notable Accomplishments

  - Increasing Low



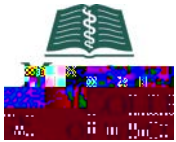
# Student Award: Jack M. Keegan

    - Education Coordinator for the Homelessness Outreach in Medical Education Project



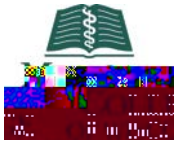
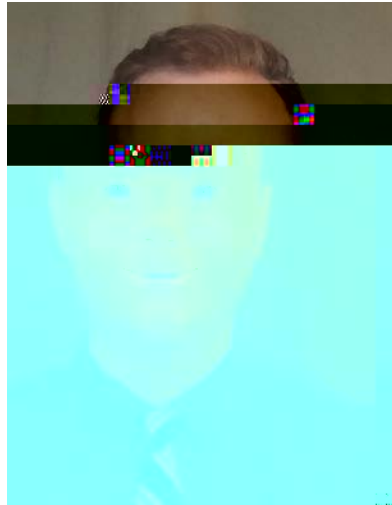
